AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMBINED ANNUAL BUDGET
AND APPROPRIATING SUCH SUMS OF MONEY AS MAY BE DEEMED
NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES AND
LIABILITIES OF THE CRETE PARK DISTRICT, WILL COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2025, AND ENDING
APRIL 30, 2026, AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES
FOR WHICH SUCH APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE AND THE
AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OBJECT AND PURPOSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Crete Park District:

SECTION I: The following is the Annual Budget for the Crete Park District for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026, and the following sums of money in the total amount of THREE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$3,859,100.00), or so much thereof as may be authorized by law be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate business of the Crete Park District as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026.

SECTION II: As part of the annual budget, it is stated:

- (a) That the cash on hand on 5-1-25 (beginning of the fiscal year) is \$287,659.29, which does not include the first installment of 2024 real estate tax collections.
- (b) That the estimated cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources is \$2,902,729.00.
- (c) That the estimated expenditures contemplated for the fiscal year are \$3,859,100.00.
- (d) That the estimated amount of real estate taxes to be received by the Crete Park District during the fiscal year is \$951,936.07.

SECTION III: The receipts and the revenues of the said Crete Park District derived from sources other than taxation from the preceding fiscal year not required for the purpose for which they were appropriated and levied shall constitute the General Fund and shall first be placed to the credit of such fund.

SECTION IV: That all unexpended balances of any item or items of any general appropriation made in this ordinance be expended in making up for any insufficiency in any item or items in the same general appropriation for the same general purpose of any like appropriations made by this ordinance.

SECTION V: That all unexpended balances of annual appropriations of previous years are hereby reappropriated.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its **SECTION VI:** passage and approval, and the same shall remain so from and after its passage and approval, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII: That the Secretary of the Crete Park District shall make and file with the County Clerk of Will County, Illinois, a duly certified copy of this ordinance in accordance with the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.
